We are thankful to report to you that we arrived safely in Mexico City on Wednesday night!

How we got here:

We left our house in Greenville, SC at 11:00 p.m. Sunday, May 24. By the next morning, we were in Biloxi, Mississippi in time for breakfast. We spent Monday night in Victoria, Texas, and crossed the border into Mexico Tuesday afternoon. By this time, I think Paul had concluded that we had moved into the van for life. This notion was confirmed for him the next day when we made the 12-hour drive through Mexico. However, we reached our new home at 10:00 p.m. Wednesday, and we've avoided long road trips for the last three days.

What we've been doing:

Thursday was spent unpacking our belongings and setting up house. Friday and Saturday Jon and Mike Goldfuss, the missionary with whom we will be working, attended an evangelism conference over two hours away. And no, it wasn't in another city. This city is just big. A two-and-a-half hour trip by taxi, bus, and metro took them to the center of the city.

Friday, Andrea got some experience buying food from a little shop down the street. Did you know they buy eggs by the kilogram here? Our kilo had sixteen eggs. And the seven we've eaten so far have been very good.

Paul is making friends with the Goldfuss children and having a great time on their trampoline. He's already picked up enough Spanish to argue over a toy. "Mía!" "No, Mía!" The vocabulary lesson had to be cut short as we handled the matter of sharing. He also loves taxis. He sees one about every two seconds while we are in the car.

We were very excited to attend the church service here today. It was good to worship with many people that we met on our mission trip here in 2005 and to see evidences of growth in their lives.

We appreciate so much your prayers that our presence would be a help to the Goldfuss family and that God would use us to extend the Gospel here.
